Junior Firefighters

Capacity Building funding has been requested for the Junior Firefighters program through the Dove Creek Volunteer Fire Department. This funding would be to provide equipment for a career pathway for young firefighters and/or medical personnel. The request was for seven (7) helmets @ \$208/helmet. The total would be \$1,456.

They will ask for a discount of ten (10) helmets were purchased. The funding of this program could be a long-term training program for the youth of the community. Funding is to be taken out of capacity building.
