NEW BUSINESS

FBLA Funding Request

FBLA sponsor Prentael Coker and students Nolan Hankins and Walker Cressler made a presentation to the Resident Team concerning funding needed for their State trip. An email with questions and answers was presented. Information about the number of students that could possibly be eligible for State, the cost of the hotel, and transportation was supplied.

Ellen Warren asked about any fundraising that had been done. Student Council has been working on a motion for fundraising. Different ideas could be a movie night or selling candy bars. Each organization is only allowed two (2) fundraisers per club. Shauna Snyder asked about concessions. They have checked and the concessions are booked for the semester unless there are cancellations. FBLA is required to stay at the designated hotel even though it is \$200/night or not be eligible to participate at the State level. That requirement will be for the next 5 years. Districts are held next week with the top 3 of each event becoming eligible to go to State. There are 13-16 kids presently that could compete in Districts. School will only help with transportation.
