Mental Health Assistance for Community

Ronda Lancaster reported that she had called the Dove Creek Clinic. The Clinic is trying to find a mental health professional but have had little luck. All mental health issues are done virtually out of Durango.

Robbie reported that the County Commissioners discussed this at their meeting. Malynda Evans is providing virtual through Dolores County Social Services. For TCV to provide a professional did not seem realistic.

Anita felt that TCV could open a can of works that would not be able to put the lid back on. TCV should make the numbers and resources known. This should be sufficient.

Shauna said that the school is offering this kind of services. To provide a mental health professional through TCV would be a lot of responsibility.

Ronda will put together a list of resources and organize so that community members would know what is available and where to call.

Critical Thinking

The water wagon has been delivered to the park. Brett Martin, DC Mayor has asked that we provide plaques for all of the historical items in the park. We will need to research the history of each item. Anita will do research on the types of plaques that are available. A list of community members that might have the history was Dan Johnson, Audrey Garchar, Jim Fisher, Kristy Chadd, Doug Stowe.

Cecil asked about the building across from the First Baptist Church. Shauna reported that it was being rented by Tim Myers.

Cecil also asked if anyone knew who owned the theatre and what could happen to bring the building back to being safe.

Lindsay reported that the school will open Wednesday, August 19. Teachers will wear masks. Elementary students will not have to wear masks, high school/middle school students will wear masks. There is one active case of COVID-19 in Dove Creek and one recovered case in Rico. Testing is available.

Lindsay has had one child tested that took 30-45 minutes. Cecil has been tested with results in 30 minutes. There are two different types of tests. If just wanting to know it takes 5-7 days for results. If there are symptoms, a rapid test is done with results in short period of time.
